BCOG currently only holds your name and e-mail address. Only the Chair and Secretary hold this information electronically, in a password-protected folder. In order to maintain your privacy we use the Blind Carbon Copy (Bcc) function when communicating with you by e-mail.

BCOG only uses your personal data to communicate with you about BCOG work sessions, events, meetings and newsletters. We do not use it to promote external causes or events, and it will not be shared with any 3rd party. It is only in circumstances where BCOG is legally required to do so that your personal data will be shared.
